Resolution

Waltham Forest Race Equality Council is very much concerned about the increasing number of knife attacks in this borough and elsewhere in London, causing injuries and deaths.

The WFREC welcomes the steps being taken by the police in the form of Operation Blunt 2 and "Stop and Search" to reduce these attacks.

The WFREC asks the Local Authority to take strong measures in co-ordination with the police, involving parents and school teachers to stop young people carrying knives and thus injuring and killing each other.

The WFREC urges the Central Government to find out the root causes which induce young people to indulge in such horrendous crimes and try to eradicate these root causes by all possible means on a priority basis, before many more valuable lives are lost.
