The Service

To provide accommodation / support to those the court considers eligible for bail (defendants on remand or in court) or the Governor considers eligible for HDC but have no suitable address or require additional support

Exclusions

- Any person who represents a high risk of serious harm to others
- Any person with a history of or an alleged sexual offence
- Any person with a previous conviction for Arson in the past 10 years

Outcomes

- Access to benefits
- Improved independent living skills
- Household Management
- Commitment to resisting re-offending
- Move on accommodation
- Support with preparation for employment
- Into employment!
