**Briefing**

This data comes from the Performance Information Bureau (PIB) statistics. The information relates to the figures for January 2008. The Borough Commander will have the most up to date figures available on the 27th

Waltham Borough Police have been set some challenging targets this year, both reduction targets and Sanctioned Detection targets.

Amongst the most challenging are the targets for Personal Robbery and Residential Burglary.

**Personal Robbery - we have been set a reduction Target of – 1%  
Currently we are achieving a – 25.6%**

**Residential Burglary - we have been set a target of – 6%  
Currently we are achieving – 4.3%**

**Theft person (target is -10%) currently we are –12.6%**

**Gun Enabled Crime (target is - 5%) currently we are +6.3%**

**Criminal Damage (target is –10%) currently we are –7.8%**

**Common Assault (target is 5%) currently we are –8.1%**

**Theft of MV (target is -10%) currently we are - 5%**

**Domestic Violence (target is 40%) currently we are 42.3%**

**Homophobic Crime (target is 33%) currently we are 33.3%**

**Rape (target is 30%) currently we are 35.6%**

## Critical Incidents

At approx 2242 on Friday 14.3.08 an on-duty police constable was in collision with a Gilera moped in Lea Bridge Road, E10.

The male officer was responding to reports of a stolen car in the area and had alighted from his patrol vehicle in order to flag down the driver of the moped and speak to him in connection with the enquiry.

The driver of the moped failed to stop for the officer and was in collision with him.

The police officer suffered a suspected broken leg and was taken by ambulance to an east London hospital where he is in a stable condition.

The driver of the moped, an 18-year-old male, was detained at the scene by officers.

He was taken by LAS to a north London hospital with minor injuries and subsequently discharged.

He has been arrested on suspicion of dangerous driving and is currently in custody at an east London police station.

Officers from Waltham Forest are investigating the incident.

## **Other news**

### **Integration Prosecution team**

IPT went live on Waltham Forest Borough on 21st May 2007.

On 22nd February 2008 Waltham Forest signed off the IPT project, although the CPS have commissioned an independent health and safety review as CPS have raised issues around accommodation pressures.

A further sign-off procedure has been agreed under auspices of the IPT project board. This will give everyone the opportunity to make progress on key issues and assess progress.

In principle the IPT project has achieved its aims of reducing duplication of work, taking the admin burden away from police officers and improving VCOP (Victims Code of Practice) ensuring victims and witnesses are contacted and supported throughout the court process. The new Optimum Business Model has recently been set up by CPS, the team ensure efficient delivery of information to police officers, witness care unit and the local courts.
