HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 124

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF WALTHAM FOREST (STOPPING UP OF PRIVATE MEANS OF ACCESS TO PREMISES AT FOREST ROAD) ORDER 2007.

The LONDON BOROUGH OF WALTHAM FOREST ("the Council") **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that it has made an Order under section 124 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the Council to stop up private means of access to premises from the A503 Forest Road to:

- (1) the commuter car park owned by London Underground Limited and located on Forest Road, London E17 and approximately 100 metres to the West of its junction with Blackhorse Lane and
- (2) to units 1,2,3 and 4 of the Forest Works Industrial Units, London E17 and adjacent access road and parking areas also located on the North side of Forest Road and approximately 52 metres to the West of its junction with Blackhorse Lane

because it considers that the means of access are likely to cause danger to traffic on that highway.

Copies of the Order and of the plan referred to therein (such plan showing the private means of access to be stopped up and the route(s) of the new means of access to the relevant premises to be provided by the Council) may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at Waltham Forest Town Hall, Forest Road, London E17 4JF.

Any person may, not later than 26 February 2007, object to the making of the Order by notice in writing to the Council at Environmental Services, Engineering Group, Room 109, Chingford Municipal Offices, 16 The Ridgeway, London E4 6PS stating the grounds of objection.
