Persons objecting to the grant of a licence must be prepared to attend in person before a Committee of the Council.

This notice must be completed on the same day on which the application is made and must be exhibited on a conspicuous part of the premises where it can easily be seen and read by persons in the street. The Notice must be kept exhibited for not less than **28 days**.
