ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

THE WALTHAM FOREST (MONTAGUE ROAD E11) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MEASURES) (NO. 1) ORDER 2021

Made **25th November 2021**

Coming into operation **25th November 2021**

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹ as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991², and of all other powers thereunto enabling and being the Traffic Authority for certain roads in that borough are satisfied that to allow access to a temporary parking area whilst construction traffic are being carried out on land adjacent to the highway and also dropped-kerb (crossover) works to be carried out in a safe and efficient manner it hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on **25th November 2021** and shall remain in force until the Council considers the Order is no longer required and may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Montague Road E11) (Temporary Traffic Measures) (No. 1) Order 2021
2. Subject to Article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load:
 - a) between the hours of 8am and 4pm Mondays-Fridays in Montague Road E11 on the:
 - (i) west side – between a point 8.5 metres south of the southern kerb line of Cookes Close E11 and the southern wall of No. 26 Montague Road E11;
 - (ii) east side - between the southern boundary of No 91 Montague Road E11 and the common boundary of Nos. 26 and 28 Montague Road E11;
 - (iii) west side – between a point 6 metres north of its junction with Acacia Road E11 northwards for a distance of 24 metres; and
 - (iv) east side - between a point 6 metres north of its junction with Briscoe Close E11 northwards for a distance of 19 metres;
 - or
 - b) "at any time" in Montague Road E11 on the:
 - (i) east side - between a point 19 metres south of the southern boundary of No 91 Montague Road E11 southwards for a distance of 7 metres;
 - (ii) east side - between a point 19 metres north of the northern kerb line of Briscoe Close E11 northwards for a distance of 7 metres;
3. The provisions of Article 2 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering, as the case may be, of the appropriate traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016³.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply:
 - (a) in relation to a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes; or
 - (b) in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
