- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (hereinafter termed "the Council") under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 proposes to *introduce raised speed tables on either an existing zebra crossing, pedestrian refuge or signalised crossing point in:
 - (a) Hall Lane E4 (HL) between (1) Nos. 252 and 256 HL and (2) No. 299 and 301 HL; and
 - (b) Chingford Mount Road (CMR) between (1) Nos. 221 and 223 CMR (2) Nos. 186 and 192 CMR (3) Nos. 54 and 58 and (4) adjacent to No. 87 CMR; and
 - (c) Chingford Road (CR) between Nos. 53 and 55 CR

*Note:

- Unless otherwise stated raised table lengths will range between 9 and 13 metres including the gradients.
- Parking on any raised section of highway above the existing highway is a contravention and is prohibited under section 86 of The Traffic Management Act 2004 (exceptions apply).
- All road/speed humps and speed tables mentioned in this Notice would be elevated sections of carriageway, between 75 and 100 millimetres higher at their highest point than the surrounding carriageway, or at an equal level with the surrounding pavement and extending across the full width of the carriageway, including the gradients. All road/speed humps and table lengths mentioned in this notice above include the gradients.
- 2. FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under section 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended to introduce a 20-m.p.h. speed limit on the following parts of roads:
 - (a) **Chingford Mount Road E4 (CMR)** between the common boundary of Nos. 266 and 268 CMR and its junction with Chingford Road E4
 - (b) **Chingford Road E4 (CR)** between its junction with Chingford Mount Road E4 and Nos. 40 and 42 CR; and
 - (c) Hall Lane E4 (HL) (north to south arm) between its junction with Hall Lane (west to east arm) and a point 3 metres north of the common boundary of Nos. 303 and 305 HL.

In the case of all roads mentioned above this would be reducing the speed limit from 30 m.p.h. .

- 3. A copy of the Orders, the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and plans showing the locations and effect of the Orders and other measures can be inspected until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, the hump measures are implemented or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders or proceed with the hump measures, on request by either emailing traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk, or visiting (*by appointment) the Highways and Traffic Management office, Low Hall. - 4. Any person desiring to object to or to make any other representation with regards to the hump measures or the Orders mentioned should send a statement in writing of either their objection and the grounds thereof or of their representation to Traffic Orders, Highways and Traffic Management, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS or by emailing: traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk quoting reference T33ab(23) Hall Lane, Chingford Mount Road and Chingford Road E4 20 m.p.h. speed limit by the end of a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
