STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council has considered it necessary to introduce the above experimental Orders to move certain roads from the LPN CPZ into the BP CPZ due to certain modal filter and other prescribed route experimental orders dividing access to roads within the same CPZ. Minor lining corrections will also be done in front of parking bays on the footway.

The orders are intended to ensure parking is more accessible for residents within the consultation area who are affected by changes to access points due to the provision of modal filters as part of the revised Lloyd Park and Higham Hill Improvement Scheme.

In the making of these Orders consideration has been given to securing expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway.

The Orders are being introduced on experimental basis in order to assess their effectiveness and in certain circumstances, changed quickly should it be deemed necessary.

In due course the Council intends to consider making permanent Orders which would continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Orders.
