The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 2024

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to replace existing parking provision (permit parking, pay-by-phone / short stay parking) with electric vehicle charging places at the locations detailed in the Schedule to this Notice. The electric vehicle charging places would be available "at any time" for the use of any electric vehicle whilst charging at an adjacent electric vehicle charging post (posts situated on island build-outs 1.5 metres in length between charging places), limited to a maximum period of 4 hours, between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays. Each location mentioned in the Schedule of this notice with up to 4 spaces will provide between 20 and 24.1 metres of charging space and 2 charging posts. Each location mentioned in the Schedule of this notice with up to 2 charging spaces will provide between 11 and 13 metres of charging space and 1 charging post. Each charging post will provide 2 connection points.
