INSPECTOR MODIFICATIONS TO A LOCAL PLAN
BLACKHORSE LANE AREA ACTION PLAN
WALTHAM FOREST LOCAL PLAN**

On 28th February 2014, the Council submitted the Blackhorse Lane Area Action Plan to the Planning Inspectorate for independent examination. The document provides planning policies and guidance on the regeneration of key sites, and will be used alongside other Local Plan documents to determine planning applications within the Blackhorse Lane Area.

As a result of the examination, the Planning Inspector assessing the Plan has proposed a schedule of Main Modifications to the Blackhorse Lane Area Action Plan. It is the Council's view that these Modifications strengthen and improve the AAP and thus the Council's ambitions for the area. The Council has also prepared a schedule of Additional Minor Modifications to the Plan.
