ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

**THE WALTHAM FOREST (MATLOCK ROAD) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MEASURES) (NO. *) ORDER 2021
(TT7(21))**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest **HEREBY GIVES NOTICE** that it intends on making an Order to enable access for construction traffic to works on land adjacent to the carriageway to be maintained in a safe and efficient manner.
2. The effect of the Order would be to temporarily:
 - (a) suspend the Zone 'AM' permit holders parking places within the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice; and
 - (b) prohibit all vehicles from waiting or loading/unloading for any purpose, between 9.30am and 2.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 9am and 1.30pm on Saturdays in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
3. The restrictions referred to in paragraph 2 of this Notice would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs and the restrictions referred to in paragraph 2(a) of this Notice would not apply in relation to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes.
4. Vehicles waiting or loading in disregard of the Order would be removed.
5. The Order would come into force on **4th March 2021** and would continue in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

SCHEDULE

Matlock Road: (a) **the west side**, between a point 5.6 metres north-east of a point in line with the southern wall of No. 12 Matlock Road and a point 16.5 metres north of a point in line with that wall; (b) **the north-west side**, between a point 5.4 metres south-west of a point in line with the south-western wall of No. 16 Matlock Road and a point 12.6 metres south-west of a point in line with that wall; and (c) **the east and south-east side**, between a point 3.5 metres north of a point in line with the northern wall of No. 14 Matlock Road and a point 19.8 metres north of a point in line with that wall.
