Notice of adoption of a Development Plan Document

Waltham Forest Local Development Framework (LDF)
Core Strategy

In accordance with Regulation 24(2) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, notice is hereby given that Waltham Forest Council adopted the LDF Core Strategy as a Development Plan Document on 1 March 2012. The Core Strategy is the principal document of the Local Development Framework and sets out the long term spatial vision and strategy for delivering and managing growth in Waltham Forest over the next 15 years.

Mr Paul Clark MA, MRTPI MCMI, an independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government considered the Core Strategy at an Examination in Public held on 26 September 2011 and 3 October 2011. The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations was received by the Council on 1 December 2011 and is published on the Council's website. The adopted Core Strategy contains the Inspector's recommendations that are binding on the Council.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made no later than the end of the six week period from the date of adoption (1st March 2012).
