Core Strategy Proposed Submission

Waltham Forest Council has prepared the proposed submission version of the LDF Core Strategy. The document sets out the long term spatial vision and strategy for delivering and managing growth in Waltham Forest over the next 15 years (to 2026). The Core Strategy Proposed Submission document is accompanied by other supporting documents including Sustainability Appraisal, Habitats Regulations Assessment, Equality Impact Assessment and the Core Strategy Preferred Options Consultation Report.

Representations procedure

The proposed submission documents are being published in order for representations to be made prior to submission to the Secretary of State for examination. Representations received during this period will be considered alongside the submitted LDF Core Strategy by an independent Planning Inspector. The purpose of the examination is to consider whether the LDF Core Strategy complies with legal requirements and is 'sound' against the tests of soundness. To be 'sound' the Core Strategy must be justified, effective and consistent with national policy. Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specific address about the submission of the LDF Core Strategy for examination.

All comments must be made on a 'representation' form which is available at the above venues and on the Council's website www.walthamforest.gov.uk/ldf and submitted as below. Representations must be received by **5pm on Monday 28 February 2011**.
