I have read the letter from Gordon Turpin, Chair of the Highams Park Planning Group, dated 17th January 2023, and agree with all the points in his letter.

I objected last year to the original plans and have not changed my mind regarding excessive height, density and massing of both developments.

I would also like to bring to your attention the group of mature trees on the west side of Larkswold Road in Site SA68. The trees provide habitat for thousands of birds, insects, worms and creatures living above and below ground. They also provide a breath of fresh air as you walk by and welcome shade on a hot Summer's day.

Developers often say trees will be re-planted after the development is completed. However, with the tipping point of the climate emergency fast approaching, I fear we may not have 100 years for the trees to grow.
