

## Notice of review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations

## Notice is hereby given that:

- Waltham Forest Borough Council ('the Council') is conducting a review of the polling districts, polling places and polling stations that fall within the London Borough of Waltham Forest.
- 2. The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the Parliamentary Constituencies of Chingford & Woodford Green, Leyton & Wanstead, and Walthamstow has made comments on the proposals which are published on the Council's website and made available at Walthamstow Library in accordance with the timetable set out below.
- Electors within the London Borough of Waltham Forest, or the Parliamentary Constituencies of Chingford & Woodford Green, Leyton & Wanstead, or Walthamstow may make a representation.
- 4. The Council welcomes the views of residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on the proposals or other related matters.
- Persons or bodies making representations against the use of a particular polling place should, if possible, suggest alternatives that may be used instead, and reasons why these should be considered.
