Notice is hereby given that Waltham Forest Council has prepared and submitted its local plan - Shaping the Borough, Waltham Forest Local Plan (LP1) for independent examination to the Secretary of State for the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government. The Plan was submitted on 30 April 2021.

Submission of the Local Plan is in accordance with Section 20 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and Regulation 22(3) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. This follows publication of the Proposed Submission version of the Plan for public consultation during the period 26 October – 14 December 2020.
