### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The above Orders are considered necessary to provide adequate on-street parking facilities for doctors and to revise previously made proposals in Oakhill (a reduction in the extents of double yellow lines) and to ensure space is provided for vehicles entering or exiting off street facilities.

The Orders also seek to correct minor drafting discrepancies to previously made Orders or to make Orders for the sites mentioned and described in item 3 of the Notice of Proposals and to add in missing scheduling of on-street parking or no waiting arrangements. No changes will be made on the highway.

The Orders also formalise the no entry signs in operation certain roads mentioned in the notice of proposals by Traffic Order so that adequate enforcement can occur against those in contravention of these signs.

To correct the traffic order schedule of waiting restrictions in Hatherley Mews from single yellow line to double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions.

All provisions are to secure the expeditious convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic on and off the highway (as per Traffic Management Act 2004 Part II).
