Parenting course information

Triple P 0-12

A broad-based parenting intervention delivered over eight weeks for parents of children up to 12-years.

For promoting their child's development and potential or concerns about their child's behavioural problems or wish to prevent behaviour problems from developing.

Triple P Teen

A broad-based parenting intervention delivered over eight weeks for parents of teenagers up to 16-years who are interested in learning a variety of parenting skills.

For promoting their teenager's development and potential or concerns about their teenager's behaviour.

Triple P Stepping Stones

A broad-based parenting intervention delivered over nine weeks for parents of children with a disability up to 12-years.

A range of exercises to learn about causes of child behaviour problems, setting specific goals, and using strategies to promote child development, manage misbehaviour, and plan for high-risk situations.

Strengthening Families, Strengthening Communities (SFSC)

A 13 week course, delivered in 3 hour sessions, for parents of children aged 0-18 years old.

Designed to support to raise happy and successful children by getting access to information and strategies for bringing up children, meeting other parents, and making sure your voice is heard.

Strengthening Families, Strengthening Communities (SFSC) workshop

A 4 week introductory workshop, delivered in 2 hour sessions, for parents of children aged 0-18 years old.

Designed to support to raise happy and successful children by getting access to information and strategies for bringing up children, meeting other parents, and making sure your voice is heard.

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS)

A 2 week course, delivered in one 2 hour session and one 2 ½ hour session for parents with children with autism, a learning disability, and a range of other complex care needs up to 18 years old

The overall aim of Positive Behaviour Support is to improve the quality of life for the person, their family, and to create opportunities for meaningful engagement with day-to-day life.
