EXPERIMENTAL INTRODUCTION OF CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES (CPZs) COOLGARDIE (CG) CPZ - T19a(23) and HIGHAMS PARK STATION (HPS) CPZ - T19b(23)

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (the Council) on **6th April 2023** made the following Orders under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come into force on **17th April 2023** and may continue in force for up to 18 months.

- (a) In relation to **COOLGARDIE (CG) CPZ**:
 - The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 165) Experimental Order 2023; and
 - The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 164) Experimental Order 2023.
- (b) In relation to **HIGHAMS PARK STATION (HPS) CPZ**
 - The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 166) Experimental Order 2023, and
 - The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 165) Experimental Order 2023.

2. The general effect of the Orders referred to in paragraph 1(a) above will be, as an experiment, to:

- (a) provide a controlled parking zone (CPZ) to be called the **Coolgardie (CG) CPZ** in Coolgardie Avenue, E4, (between Larkshall Road and the northern arm of Warboys Crescent); and
- (b) introduce permit holder parking places throughout the length of Coolgardie Avenue referred to above, with single yellow line waiting restrictions to protect vehicle crossovers;
- (c) formalise the disabled persons' parking bay outside No. 20 Coolgardie Avenue, by placing a traffic sign at that location. *The short stay parking bay and disabled persons' parking bay outside No. 48 will remain unchanged.*
- (d) provide that the "controlled hours" of the permit parking places and single yellow lines in the Coolgardie (CG) CPZ will be between **10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays**;
- (e) provide that the properties eligible to apply for permits in the Coolgardie (CG) CPZ are specified in **Schedule 1** of this Notice.

3. The general effect of the Orders referred to in paragraph 1(b) above will be, as an experiment, to:

- (a) provide a controlled parking zone (CPZ) to be called the **Highams Park Station (HPS) CPZ** which will include:
 - (i) Beech Hall Road, E4, (between Beech Hall Crescent and Hale End Road);
 - (ii) Beverley Road, E4; and
 - (iii) Hale End Road, E4, (between Larkshall Road and Beverley Road);
- (b) introduce permit holder parking places throughout the lengths of Beech Hall Road and Beverley Road referred to in paragraph 3(a) above with single yellow line waiting restrictions to protect vehicle crossovers and double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions:
 - (i) at the north-eastern extremity of Beverley Road; and
 - (ii) across the kerb build-out adjacent to No. 100 Beech Hall Road.

Note: The existing short-stay parking places in Beech Hall Road and Beverley Road, the disabled person's parking bay outside Nos 4 and 90 Beech Hall Road and the car club bay in Beverley Road will be retained. There will be no changes to kerb-side controls in Hale End Road.

- (c) provide that the "controlled hours" of the permit parking places and single yellow lines in the Highams Park Station (HPS) CPZ will be between **8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays**.

- (d) provide that the properties eligible to apply for permits in the Highams Park Station (HPS) CPZ are specified in **Schedule 2** of this Notice.

4. The Orders will also provide that:

- (a) residents' permits, business permits, charity permits, visitors' permits, school staff term-time only permits, residents' foreign vehicle permits and essential user/carers permits may be issued, on payment of the appropriate charge as specified in **Schedule 3** to this Notice, to a person who is the keeper of a passenger vehicle (having 8 passenger seats or less), certain goods carrying vehicles and invalid carriages, providing that in the case of -
 - (i) a residents' permit, they are a resident of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in the relevant Schedule to this Notice and their vehicle is UK registered to that address;
 - (ii) a foreign vehicles residents' permit, they are a resident of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and their vehicle is registered outside of the UK;
 - (iii) a business/charity permit/business visitor's permit, they have a business in a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in the relevant Schedule to this Notice and that the permit is for a vehicle which is essential to the operation of that business/charity and is used in the purchase and sale of goods or services in connection with that business/charity;
 - (iv) an essential users/carers permit, they are a doctor or carer who has a surgery in or works in the London Borough of Waltham Forest, or employed by or contracted to the Council, or employed by or contracted to a health authority, or employed by the Metropolitan Police, or employed by the London Fire and Civil Defence Authority, or a company that services fire-fighting appliances and for whom the use of a vehicle is essential to the carrying out of their public service duties in a street or part of a street specified in paragraph 2(a) or 3(a) above;
 - (v) a school staff term-time only permit, they are a registered member of staff at a primary or secondary school situated in a street or part of a street specified in sub-paragraph 2(a) or 3(a) above, who has a bona fide reason to drive to that school and who lives or is based outside the Borough.
- (b) vehicles displaying any valid permit displaying the letters:
 - (i) **CG** may use the permit parking placed provided in the street specified in paragraph 2(a) above;
 - (ii) **HPS** may use the permit parking places provided in the streets and parts of streets specified in paragraph 3(a)(i) and (ii) above.

5. The charges for permits and vehicle class are specified in **Schedule 3** to this Notice.

6. Where it appears necessary for certain purposes, an authorised officer of the Council may, in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, modify or suspend any provision of the experimental Traffic Orders while they are in force.

8. The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Orders should be continued in force indefinitely by means of permanent Orders made under sections 6, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Any person may object to the making of the permanent Orders for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of six months beginning with the day on which the experimental Orders come into force or, if the Orders are varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force. Any such objection must be made in writing and must state the grounds on which it is made and be sent to Traffic Orders, Highways, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS, or by emailing: traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk quoting:

- (a) in respect of an Order referred to in paragraph 1(a) above, reference **T19a(23) - COOLGARDIE (CG) CPZ**; or
- (b) in respect of an Order referred to in paragraph 1(b) above, reference **T19b(23) - HIGHAMS PARK STATION (HPS) CPZ**

Any objection may be communicated to, or be seen by, other persons who may be affected.

9. If any person wishes to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

Coolgardie Avenue, E4 - Nos. 1 to 43 (odds), Nos. 2 to 70 (evens)

SCHEDULE 2

(Properties whose occupiers will be eligible to purchase permits to park in **Highams Park Station (HPS) CPZ**)

- Beech Hall Road, E4** - Nos. 1 to 83b (odds)
 - Nos. 2 to 100 (evens), *except for property Nos. 2A and 2B which are eligible for visitor permits only*
- Beverley Road, E4** - All properties
- Hale End Road, E4** - Nos. 400 to 428 (evens)
 - Nos. 477 to 495 (odds)
