PERMANENT MAKING OF EXPERIMENTAL CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES (CPZ) (T24abcd(23))

TUDOR ROAD (TU) (T24a(23)), WADHAM ROAD (WD) (T24b(23)), EXTENSION OF ABBOTTS PARK/MIDLAND (AM) (T24c(23))AND DAYS EXTENSION OF LEYTON WEST (LNW) (T24d(23)) CPZS

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 1st June 2023 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The general effect of the Orders will be to:
- (a) continue indefinitely the provisions of The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 127) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to *TU CPZ*]; and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 127) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to *TU CPZ*] the effects of which:
 - (i) provided a new CPZ in **Tudor Road E4** comprising '**TU'** permit holders parking places, operating between the hours of **7.30 a.m. and 10.30 p.m. Monday to Sundays**, on both sides, except in places where new waiting restrictions were provided:
 - (ii) introduced new lengths of waiting restrictions operating between **7.30 a.m. and 10.30 p.m. Monday to Sundays** (single yellow lines) in the remainder of the street between the permit holders parking places referred to in item 1(a)(i) preceding and alongside double yellow lines already in place prior to the experiment;
 - (iii) included all properties in Tudor Road E4 in the eligibility list for 'TU' parking permits and visitor permits (excluding any 'car free' property); and
 - (iv) permitted vehicles displaying any valid permit displaying the letters '**TU**' to use any of the permit parking places provided in Tudor Road E4.
- (b) continue indefinitely the provisions of The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 128) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to WD CPZ]; and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 128) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to WD CPZ] the effects of which:
 - (i) provided a new CPZ in **Wadham Road E17** between No. 103 and 205 Wadham Road; and **Wadham Avenue E17** between its junction with Wadham Road and the northern boundary of Nos. 55 and 56 Wadham Avenue operating between the hours of **7.30 a.m. and 10.30 p.m. Monday to Sundays**.
 - (ii) provided a Free Short Stay parking place operating between **7.30 a.m.** and **10.30 p.m. Monday to Sundays** with a 1-hour free stay and no return in 3 hours outside Nos. 147 and 155 Wadham Road.

- (iii) governed entry and parking within the CPZ mentioned in item 1(b)(i) preceding by the signs "Permit holders parking only past this point" with no specific parking places marked on the carriageway.
- (iv) included property: Nos. 1 to 56 Wadham Avenue E17; Nos. 103 to 205 Wadham Road E17 (odds only) and Nos. 196 to 202 Winchester Road E4 in the eligibility list for 'WD' parking permits and visitor permits (excluding any 'car free' property) and
- (v) permitted vehicles displaying any valid permit displaying the letters '**WD**' to park within the sections of roads mentioned in item 1(b)(i) preceding.
- (c) continue indefinitely the provisions of The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 129) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to AM CPZ (extn 1)]; and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 129) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to AM CPZ (extn 1)] the effects of which:
- (i) provided new 'AM' CPZ permit holders parking places in Leyton Green Road (LGR) E10 (1) between Nos. 107 and 115, (2) at two locations between Nos. 76 and 92, and (3) in seven locations between Matlock Road and Cheltenham Road, operating between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday.
- (ii) introduced new lengths of **8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday** waiting restrictions (single yellow lines) between the permit holders parking places referred to in item 1(c)(i) preceding, (1) on the east and south-east sides outside Nos. 20-22, 32, 34, 38, 88-90 LGR and across the garage entrance to the rear of No. 2 Matlock Road, and (2) outside No. 115 LGR;
- (iii) provided a Free Short Stay parking place operating between **8 a.m.** and **6.30 p.m. Monday to Fridays** with a 1-hour free stay and no return in 3 hours outside Nos. 34 and 36 LGR.
- (iv) included property:
 - (i) Nos. 18-36 LGR inclusive (evens); Flats 1-47 No. 38 Whitehouse (inclusive), off LGR; Nos. 38A-64E Whitehouse Estate inclusive (evens), off LGR; Nos. 78-90 and 110-130 inclusive (evens) LGR and Nos. 99 and 105-117 inclusive (odds) LGR; and Nos. 1-24 inclusive, Whitehouse Mews E10 6EY and Nos. 764 to 782 High Road, Leyton E10 (evens inclusive) in the eligibility list for 'AM' parking permits and visitor permits; and
 - (ii) No. 92 and 101 Leyton Green Road E10 for visitor permits only; and
- (v) permitted vehicles displaying any valid permit displaying the letters '**AM**' to park within parking places mentioned in item 1(c)(i) preceding or in the 'AM' CPZ in general.
- (d) continue indefinitely the provisions of The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 130) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to *LNW CPZ*]; and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 130) Experimental Order 2022 [relating to *LNW CPZ*] the effects of which amended the days of operation of the LNW CPZ so that permit parking places and single yellow line waiting restrictions operated between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

New parking permit eligibility and other criteria, along with variations in pricing for certain parking permits based on vehicle emissions will apply on the anniversary/renewal of any existing permit granted for use in the aforementioned CPZs. These conditions became effective from 1st April 2023. Further details will be explained when renewing permits, or see www.walthamforest.gov.uk/service-categories/parking-permits

- 2. The Orders will continue to provide that **residents'** permits, **business** permits, **charity** permits (*eligible for charities registered with the Charities Commission only*), **visitors'** permits, **school staff** term-time only permits, **residents' foreign** vehicle permits, **essential user** permits, **carers** permits and **tradespersons'** permits, may be granted, on payment of the appropriate charge as specified in item 4 following, to a person who is the keeper of a passenger vehicle (having 8 passenger seats or less) or a certain type of goods vehicle or a motor cycle, providing that in the case of –
- (i) a **residents'** permit, they are a resident of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and their vehicle is UK registered to that address;
- (ii) a **foreign vehicles residents'** permit, they are a resident of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and their vehicle is registered outside of the UK;

- (iii) a **business** permit or charity permit or business visitor's permit, they have a business or charitable organisation in a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and that the permit is for a vehicle which is essential to the operation of that business or charity and is used in the purchase and sale of goods or services in connection with that business or charity;
- (iv) an **essential users** permit or carers permit, they are either a doctor or carer who has a surgery in or works in the London Borough of Waltham Forest, or employed by or contracted to the Council, or employed by or contracted to a health authority, or employed by the Metropolitan Police (including Police officers), or employed by the London Fire and Civil Defence Authority, or a company that services fire-fighting appliances and for whom the use of a vehicle is essential to the carrying out of their public service duties, or to any carer registered with the Council who is in receipt of a DWP Carers Allowance and who is providing care to a resident living in a CPZ in the London Borough of Waltham Forest ('the borough'), regardless of whether or not that carer resides in the borough, in a street or part of a street specified in items 1(a)(i),1(b)(i), 1(c)(i) or 1(d) preceding; The Council will, in addition, consider applications for a carers permit on a case by case basis from carers who are not in receipt of a DWP Carers Allowance but who provide care to a resident living in a CPZ in the borough. Medical documents will need to be provided to the Council by the resident receiving care to support such an application. In such a case the carers permit will be charged at the current resident parking permit charge rates.
- (v) **school staff** term-time only permit, they are a registered member of staff at a primary or secondary school situated in a street or part of a street specified in items 1(a)(i),1(b)(i), 1(c)(i) or 1(d) preceding, who has a bona fide reason to drive to that school:
- (vi) a **tradespersons** permit, which may be applied for by CPZ residents on the behalf of tradespersons engaged in work at their home address in or near a street or part of a street specified items 1(a)(i),1(b)(i), 1(c)(i) or 1(d) preceding; or
- 3. In respect of permits to park in each individual zone, the properties specified in each experimental order will continue indefinitely and only properties specific will be able to obtain permits to park in a specific zone only.
- **4.** For all CPZs mentioned in this notice, residents and business permits will continue to be charged on a basis of CO₂ emissions (or, for older vehicles, engine size) and number of vehicles registered to a household. Residents visitor permits will continue to be obtainable as paperless permits or as scratch-cards at a rate of 70p/hour. Any charges mentioned therein may be subject to change.
- **5.** Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation from **5**th **June 2023** and all other relevant documents can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from that date on request by either emailing traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk or visiting (*by appointment) the Highways and Traffic Management office, Low Hall. Argall Avenue E10 7AS during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive; or alternatively documents can be viewed online at: www.walthamforest.gov.uk/content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations.
- **6.** Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court
