- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to replace existing parking provision (permit parking, pay-by-phone / short stay parking) with electric vehicle charging places at the locations detailed in the Schedule to this Notice. The electric vehicle charging places would be available "at any time" for the use of any electric vehicle whilst charging at an adjacent electric vehicle charging post, limited to a maximum period of 4 hours, between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays.
- 3.
