

LICENCES FOR SPECIAL TREATMENT

PUBLIC NOTICE

Within seven days of applying for a licence a notice must be published in a local newspaper which circulates in the locality in which the premises are situated.

Within fourteen days of the application being made one copy of the complete newspaper must be sent to the Licensing Service.
