STATEMENT OF REASONS

The above Order is required to provide lawful authority for the enforcement of parking and waiting restrictions on the Council's Priory Court E17 housing estate. This is necessary to ensure that parking and waiting facilities are maintained for the use of eligible residents of the estates and other permit holders agreed by the Council and to prevent parking and waiting where it could cause an obstruction, particularly to emergency services and refuse collection vehicles.

Finding space to store a bicycle at home (particularly in smaller terraced houses and flats) is difficult and this prevents people taking up cycling or limits the amount of cycles that a house can own. The Council is addressing this by installing Bike hangars. These changes are considered a benefit to the local community. By supporting more sustainable modes of travel and encouraging more walking and cycling. The provision of a cycle hangar under section 63 of the Road Traffic Act 1984 in controlled parking zones requires Orders to displace permit or other charged for or uncharged for parking space.
