The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 185) Order 2023 The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 184) Order 2023

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 28th September 2023 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders to coincide with a public realm scheme will be in:
 - (a) Church Lane E11 south-side, between a point 30 meters west of its junction with High Road Leytonstone E11 and the common boundary of Nos. 17/18 remove all parking places and loading places and replace with:
 - (i) A loading place 16.5 meters in length, extending eastwards from a point opposite the eastern boundary wall of no. 54, operating daily 7am to 7pm;
 - (ii) A pay-by-phone parking place 5 meters in length outside No. 17, operating Monday to Saturday 10am to 1pm and 2pm to 4pm, and no return within 3 hours;*
 - (b) High Road Leytonstone E11 west-side, convert 6.6 meters of pay-by-phone parking space outside No. 811 to a disabled person's parking place, operating everyday with a maximum stay of 3 hours and no return same day.
- 3. Copies of the Orders which will come into operation from 2nd October 2023 and all other relevant documents can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from that date on request by either emailing traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk or visiting (*by appointment) the Highways and Traffic Management office, Low Hall. Argall Avenue E10 7AS during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, or alternatively documents can be viewed online at: www.walthamforest.gov.uk/content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
