- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to change the days and hours of operation of the MD CPZ from operating between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays to operate between 8 a.m. and 9.30 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays (everyday) inclusive. The MD CPZ permit parking places and single yellow line waiting restrictions within the MD CPZ will operate at the new CPZ times. All other parking provision (not permit holders only) within the boundary of the MD CPZ will remain unchanged including the double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions. The roads included in the MD CPZ subject to change will be Millicent Road E10, Norton Road E10 and Dagenham Road E10.
- 3.
