The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zones)
(Amendment No. 15) Traffic Order 2023

Made 2nd November 2023

Coming into force 2nd November 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zones) (Amendment No. 15) Traffic Order 2023, shall come into force on 2nd November 2023.

2. Interpretation

In this Order, the expression:

“Order of 2021” means The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) Traffic Order 2021(b)

3. Amendment to the Order of 2021

Without prejudice to the validity to anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or any omission before the coming into operation of this Order there was added to the Schedule of the Order of 2021 the items numbered 46 to 48 (inclusive) respectively as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule attached to this Order.

4. Revocations

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zones) (No. 5) Experimental Traffic Order 2022(c) is hereby revoked in its entirety.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits all motor vehicles except permit holders from entering a pedestrian and cycle zone in streets in the vicinity of Hillyfield on the Hill primary school E17 during certain time periods at the beginning and end of the school day and forms and extension to the SC7 Pedestrian and Cycle zone, in the London Borough of Waltham Forest, as part of the Council's School Streets Scheme, on a permanent basis.
