TRAFFIC CALMING RELOCATION OF SPEED HUMP AND NEW SPEED TABLES SUTHERLAND ROAD E17, ST ANDREWS ROAD E17, STIRLING ROAD E17

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council, in accordance with Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980, the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, as amended, proposes to:
 - (a) remove and relocate an existing speed hump in **St Andrews Road E17 –** from outside Nos. 49/51 to outside Nos. 51/53.
 - (b) introduce new speed tables in Sutherland Road E17
 - i) north-south arm between the south facing wall of No. 71 and the northern boundary of No. 65;
 - ii) **east-west arm** between a point 13.5 metres and a point 28 metres south-eastward of the southern boundary of No. 55; and
 - (c) introduce blended Copenhagen crossings in Sutherland Road E17
 - i) **north-south arm** between its junction with St Andrews Road and a point 8.5 metres south-eastward from the said junction; and
 - ii) **east-west arm** between its junction with Higham Street and the common boundary of Nos. 1/3 Sutherland Road.
 - (d) introduce a blended Copenhagen crossing in **Stirling Road E17** between its junction with Sutherland Road and a point 8 metres north-westward from the said junction.

NB/ The speed tables and Copenhagen style blended crossings mentioned in this Notice would be elevated sections of carriageway, between 75 and 100 millimetres higher at their highest point than the surrounding carriageway, or at an equal level with the surrounding pavement and extending across the full width of the carriageway, including the gradients. Parking on a Copenhagen styled crossing or on any raised section of highway above the existing highway is a contravention and is prohibited under section 86 of The Traffic Management Act 2004 (exceptions apply).
