### AMENDMENT TO THE DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION OF THE MILLICENT ROAD/DAGENHAM ROAD E10 (MD) CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE (CPZ)

**The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 198) Order 2023**  
**The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping**  
**Restrictions) (Amendment No. 193) Order 2023**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on **9<sup>th</sup> November 2023** made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be to change the days and hours of operation of the **MD CPZ** from operating between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays to operate between **8 a.m. and 9.30 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays (everyday)** inclusive. The MD CPZ permit parking places and single yellow line waiting restrictions within the MD CPZ will operate at the new CPZ times. All other parking provision (not permit holders only) within the boundary of the MD CPZ will remain unchanged including the double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions. The roads included in the MD CPZ subject to change will be Millicent Road E10, Norton Road E10 and Dagenham Road E10.
3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation from **17<sup>th</sup> November 2023**, all other relevant documents can be inspected until the expiration period of 6 weeks from that date on request by either emailing [traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk](mailto:traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk) or visiting (\*by appointment) the Highways and Traffic Management office, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, E10 7AS during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive; or alternatively documents can be viewed online at: [www.walthamforest.gov.uk/content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations](http://www.walthamforest.gov.uk/content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations).
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1894, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
