The Waltham Forest (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 202*

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on * 202* and may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 202*.

Interpretation

- (1) In this Order "the Order of 2009 means The Waltham Forest (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2009².
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2009 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Amendment to the Order of 2009

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2009 shall have effect as though in paragraph (1) of Article 3 of that Order, in the meaning assigned to the expression "green pledge scheme", for the words "not more than four days per week" there were substituted the words "not more than two days per week".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends the Off Street Parking Places Order of 2009 so as to limit the maximum number of days Council Staff must commit to using their vehicles to travel to work to two times per week to qualify for the Green Pledge staff permit for use within off street parking places in the London Borough of Waltham Forest, bringing the Order in line with the way in which the scheme currently operates.
