Coppermill Liveable Neighbourhoods Scheme

Station Road area improvements update letter

In December 2023, we sent a leaflet to residents and businesses on and near Station Road and St James Street, with information about the final scheme for the area and inviting local people to share their views as part of an informal consultation.

Thank you to everyone who provided feedback on the final permanent scheme which aims to improve the look and feel of the area with raingardens, biodiverse planting, pavement resurfacing and public art, whilst also making improvements for people walking and cycling with new cycle parking and continuous footways.

After careful consideration of all feedback received, we can confirm that the scheme has been approved by Waltham Forest Council and will now proceed to the construction stage.

We will also advertise the necessary Traffic Management Order (TMO) changes (changes to parking bays and yellow lines) that are needed to deliver the scheme. The TMO changes will be advertised in the East London and West Essex Guardian on 15 February 2024, and street notices will be placed in the area with details of the changes and how to comment. If would like to send comments on the TMO changes, please contact us using the details overleaf quoting T8(24) – Station Road Public Realm Scheme before 7 March 2024 (please include your name and address).

Once the TMO statutory consultation period for the parking changes has ended, we will write to residents with more information on construction dates and planned works.
