

## Local Authorities (Referendums) (Petitions And Directions) (England) Regulations 2011 (As Amended)

## Notice is hereby given that:

 Linzi Roberts-Egan, Electoral Registration Officer for the London Borough of Waltham Forest for the purposes of the above Regulations CERTIFIES, in accordance with Regulation 4 of the said Regulations, that the number that is equal to five per cent of the local Government electorate shown on the electoral register having effect for this area on the 15<sup>th</sup> February 2024 is:

## 9,550

- This number will be used for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions presented after the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2024 and before the 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2025 seeking a referendum on whether or not there should be an elected Mayor or alternative constitutional model, unless the circumstances detailed below apply.
- If the number for 2025, to be published in February 2025, is less than 9,550, that lower number will be used for the purpose of determining the validity of petitions presented between the date the number is published and the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2025.
- 4. The number that will be used for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions presented before the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2024 is 9,529, being the number published in February 2023, and being lower than the number published at 1 above.
