

Application Checklist

Stage 1: Application
Read the available documentation on resident parklets.
☐ Create a basic design for the parklet that reflects the principles outlined in the design guidance document.
Apply online via the application link. Submit the stage one application, outlining how the parklet will benefit the local community and include preliminary design and pictures.
Stage 2: Site visit by Council Officer and remaining documents
Please complete these steps once the design and initial concept for the Community Parklet has been approved by a Council officer.
□ Detailed Design: Specific dimensions of all elements and arrangement of furniture, amenities and planting. Materials to be used and a construction method statement. Please note that there may need to be various iterations of the design prior to approval.
☐ Maintenance plan: Describe how cleaning and repairs will be undertaken throughout the length of the trial.
Risk assessment: Demonstrate consideration of associated risks and how you plan to mitigate them.
☐ Construction Method Statement: Describe your plan on how you intend to build your Community Parklet.
☐ Downloaded templates and forms, from website, including the local street consultation 'Neighbourhood Support' form.
Stage 3: Neighbourhood Support Form and evidence of Public Liability Insurance
The following steps will need to be followed once the previous stage documents have been submitted and reviewed and approved by a Council officer.
Neighbourhood Support form: A completed "Neighbourhood support form" will require at least 10 signatures from neighbours, this is to ensure the local community supports the proposal

☐ Public Liability Insurance purchased
Stage 4: Building your parklet and grant reimbursement
☐ Build your Community Parklet on the date provided by a Council Officer from the Parklet Team
☐ Grant reimbursement: Send a predacted bank statement and proof of purchases to the Parklets team via email at Parklets@walthamforest.gov.uk (please include the street name and location of the Parklet within the email)
