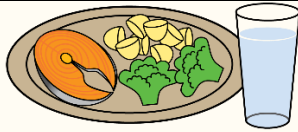
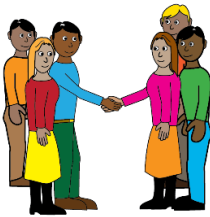

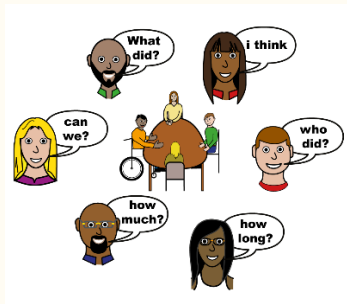
### Shared Food

We will introduce new members and visiting staff members.



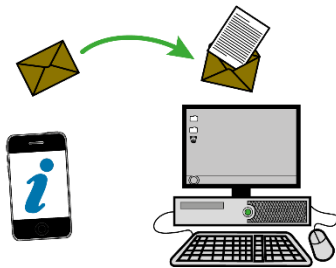
### Markhouse Centre Consultation
