Highways maintenance (resurfacing) & bus route 230 improvements scheme construction notification.

We are writing to inform you that the bus route 230 construction, along with resurfacing and reconstruction work to the carriageways on Bisterne Avenue, Avon Road and Fyfield Road, will be commencing on 10 March and is expected to be completed by the end of May. These works form part of our commitment to enhancing the public realm, improving safety, and creating a more accessible and enjoyable environment for all residents and visitors.

To enable these works and the associated bus diversion, we will need to suspend parking in Upper Walthamstow Road on the northern side between the junction of Fyfield Road and Bisterne Avenue.

We kindly ask you avoid parking in these areas during the construction period. Any vehicles obstructing the works may be subject to enforcement action, including the issuance of a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

During this period all CPZ permit holders will be able to park in the HSE CPZ along with the adjoining HE and FSR parking zones.

While every effort will be made to minimise inconvenience, some disruption is inevitable. We thank you for your understanding and patience as we carry out these improvements.

Penalty notice is £130 (discounted to £65 if paid within 14 days of issue). Detail of payment will be on the back of the ticket.

Removal of vehicles and impounded vehicles incur a charge of £65 for the penalty notice and £200 for the release of the vehicle, to be paid within the first 24 hours. After every 24-hour period a storage charge of £40 will be added.

Collection of impounded vehicles and payments for the release of a vehicle are to be made using the details outlined above.

If you suspect your vehicle may have been removed, please contact TRACE on 0300 077 0100 or text TRACE (followed by vehicle registration) to 66663 who will confirm if your vehicle has been relocated or removed to a pound (please note that charges may apply for this service).
