Dear Resident/ Business owner,

RE: Blackhorse junction overnight traffic signal works

I am writing to inform you that overnight works to install temporary traffic signals at the junction of Forest Road and Blackhorse Road will be carried out from Monday 24 June to Wednesday 26 June between 9pm and 5am.

The temporary traffic signals are required to enable us to remove the existing traffic signals and pedestrian islands making way for the new junction layout. It is essential that the work is carried out overnight due to the amount of traffic using the junction throughout the day.

Work schedule:

- Monday 24 June and Tuesday 25 June – the majority of work will be carried out between these dates such as installing poles, blocks and cables.
- Wednesday 26 June – the new temporary traffic signals will be switched on by Transport for London (TfL).

During the work the junction will still be operational, but vehicles will pass through from one route at a time. The footways will remain open and access to properties will be maintained.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and hope that you will bear with us so we can make these changes as soon as possible. Our contractor JB Riney will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum.
