

Dear Resident / Business owner,

Forest Road /Blackhorse Road Junction - Overnight Road Resurfacing

Road resurfacing work at the traffic signal junction is due to begin on the evening of Monday 29 June 2020 for two weeks.

This is essential work that cannot be carried out during the daytime due to the amount of traffic present at the junction. The resurfacing will be carried out overnight on weekdays, Monday to Friday, between 9pm and 5am.

Some disruption and noise is inevitable with this type of work, however, every effort will be made to keep inconvenience to a minimum. Subject to progress, the work should be completed by Tuesday 14 July 2020.

To allow the resurfacing to be carried out safely and efficiently, each night there will be temporary overnight closures of some of the roads leading to/from the junction. Local traffic diversions will be in force from 9pm with buses being placed on diversion.

A table showing the sequence of road closures and closure dates can be found overleaf and the works phasing plan is available online at the address below.

The emergency services have been informed of the working arrangements and access for fire, police and ambulance will be maintained throughout the work.

Between 8pm and 6am a temporary overnight parking and loading suspension will be in force on the roads leading to and from the junction.

Your help in not parking during the works would be appreciated. If vehicles are found to be parked in or around the working areas, the Council's parking enforcement contractor will issue a penalty notice and will either relocate or impound the vehicle (contact details and charges are shown overleaf).

Parking penalty charges

If you suspect your vehicle may have been removed, you should contact TRACE on 0300 0770100 or text "trace" followed by your vehicle registration to 66663, who should be able to confirm if your vehicle has been relocated or removed to a pound.

Penalty notice - £130.00 (discounted to £65.00 if paid within 14 days of issue) details of payment will be on the back of the ticket.

Removal of vehicles and impounded – a charge of £65.00 for the Penalty notice and £200.00 for the release of the vehicle to be paid within the first 24 hours, after every 24 hour period a storage charge of £40.00 will be added. Collection of Impounded vehicles and payments for the release of a vehicle are to be made at the following address.
