

CONSULTATION NOTICE

St Georges Court and Whipps Cross House E17 - Parking provision development proposal

Statutory Consultation – Secure Council Tenants of 287 and 289 Wood Street (Flats 1-124 St Georges Court & 1-22 Whipps Cross House)

Section 105 of Housing Act 1985

The Council intends to consult all secure tenants at 287 and 289 Wood Street (Flats 1-124 St Georges Court and 1-22 Whipps Cross House) about the St Georges Court and Whipps Cross House E17 parking provision development proposal. This is a “matter of housing management” that is likely substantially to affect secure tenants at these properties for the purposes of Section 105 of the Housing Act 1985.

The arrangements for this consultation are as follows:

- On or around 6th February 2017 all secure tenants at 287 and 289 Wood Street (Flats 1-124 St Georges Court & 1-22 Whipps Cross House) will be sent a ‘St Georges Court and Whipps Cross House E17 Parking provision development proposal’ Information Pack summarising the issues involved and setting out the Councils’ proposals. This pack will consist of a letter and drawing(s) of the proposals.
- Secure tenants will be invited to make their views known to the Council via email or by writing to the Council at the addresses given in the Information Pack. We will also invite views from the leaseholders within the flats as leases may need to be varied.
- Secure tenants will have 28 days to make their views known to the Council.

Before making a final decision on this matter the Council will consider any representations made in accordance with these arrangements.
