

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF WALTHAM FOREST**

### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF WALTHAM FOREST** hereby gives notice that it has made an order under Section 247 (2A) of the above Act entitled the London Borough of Waltham Forest (Stopping Up of Highways) (No. 2) to authorise the stopping up of the following area of public highway which is shown hatched black and edged red on the plan attached to the order and comprising 107m<sup>2</sup> and may be generally described as:

- (a) The area of public highway south of 69-85 and 70 to 86 Wadham Avenue

**THE ORDER IS MADE** to enable development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 17 April 2018 under reference 174257.

**ANY PERSON** aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### **THE SCHEDULE**

Erection of part three storey and part four storey building to provide 7 self-contained flats (7 x 2 bed) with seven vehicle parking spaces, cycle storage and refuse facilities. Creation of front hardstanding at existing building providing thirteen vehicle parking spaces, cycle storage and new landscaping
