MODIFICATION TO THE WALTHAM FOREST (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONES) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 2020

1. The London Borough of Waltham Forest, in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Article 4 of the above-mentioned Order and having consulted with the Commissioner of the Metropolitan Police, hereby modifies that Order as specified in paragraph 3 below for the reason specified in paragraph 2 below.
2. The modification is considered necessary due to school closures as a result of the Covid-19 lockdown and the assessment of the pedestrian and cycle zone being measured from the reopening of Henry Maynard school from 15th June 2020.
3. In order to achieve this, the experimental traffic Order will be modified to become effective from 15th June 2020 for a period of 18 months. The modification Order will be titled The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (Amendment No. 1) (Modification No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2020.
4. The Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the above-mentioned experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely by means of a permanent Order. Any person may object to the making of this permanent Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of six months beginning with the day on which the above-mentioned modification come into force. Any such objection must be made in writing and must state the grounds on which it is made and be sent to **Traffic Orders, Highways and Infrastructure, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS, or by emailing traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk quoting reference: Traffic Orders T13(20) – School streets – Maynard Road, Barclay Road, Ravenswood Road, Addison Road, Wilson Street, Comely Bank Road and Brunswick Street E17.** Any objection may be communicated to, or be seen by, other persons who may be affected.
