INTRODUCTION OF ROLLS SPORTS GROUND CAR PARK, E4 (SPORTS GROUND OFF HICKMAN ROAD) FREE SHORT STAY AND PERMIT HOLDERS OFF-STREET CAR PARK

The Waltham Forest (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 201* (T22(20))

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest (therein after called "the Council") proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 32, 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the "Off-Street" Order would be to introduce the following car park into the Off-Street Parking Places Parent Order: **ROLLS SPORTS GROUND CAR PARK E4** (entrance via Hickman Avenue) as a free short stay and permit holders car park.
- The Rolls Sports Ground car park which would be for use by motor cars, motorcycles and light goods vehicles and would operate at all times will have approximately 84 parking bays, allocated as follows: 5 disabled persons parking bays, 2 motorcycle parking bays, 6 business 'RP' permit holders parking bays and the remainder (approximately 71 bays) free 3-hour maximum stay (no return on the same day) parking bays.
- Business 'RP' permits would be available to businesses with premises at 14 Hickman Avenue, E4 and the charge for such a permit, valid for 12 months would be as follows:

single vehicle business permit (for use in any one specified motor car, motorcycle or light goods vehicle)	Charge
Engine size less than 1550cc of a vehicle registered before 1 st March 2001	£435
Engine size more than 1550cc of a vehicle registered before 1 st March 2001	£645
CO2 emissions less than 100 g/km of a vehicle registered after 1 st March 2001	£225
CO2 emissions between 101 and 170 g/km of a vehicle registered after 1 st March 2001	£435
CO2 emissions more than 170 g/km of a vehicle registered after 1 st March 2001	£645

pool use business permit (for use in any one non-specified motor car, motorcycle or light goods vehicle)	Charge
Any Engine size or CO2 emission of a vehicle registered on any date	£645

NB. Additional information with regard to parking compliance will be displayed on the Council's terms and conditions information board at the entrance and within the aforementioned car park.
