EXPERIMENTAL INTRODUCTION OF: HIGHAM HILL NORTH (HHN) (T37a(20)) AND EXPERIMENTAL EXTENSION OF: HIGHAM HILL (EXTN. 2) (T37b(20)) AND WOOD STREET NORTH (EXTN. 1) (T37c(20)) CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES (CPZS) (*all E17 streets*)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (the Council) on 17th September 2020 made:

- (a) The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 51) Experimental Order 2020 and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 51) Experimental Order 2020 [relating to *HHN CPZ*];
- (b) The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 52) Experimental Order 2020 and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 52) Experimental Order 2020 [relating to *HH-extension 2 CPZ*]; and
- (c) The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 53) Experimental Order 2020 and The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 53) Experimental Order 2020 [relating to *WSN-extension 1 CPZ*];

under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come into force from 28th September 2020 and may continue for up to 18 months from the date the Orders come into force.

2. The general effect of the Orders referred to in paragraph 1(a) above will be, as an experiment, to:-

- (a) provide a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) to be called **HIGHAM HILL NORTH (HHN)** which will include the following roads: **Amber Avenue, Cooper Avenue, Cogan Avenue, Kimberley Road, Lawrence Avenue, McEntee Avenue, Sinnott Road, Gurney Close, Travers Close, Valognes Avenue** and **Waterhall Close**
- (b) introduce new permit holder parking places and waiting restrictions into the streets and parts of streets mentioned in paragraph 2(a) above in all locations surrounding designated parking places which includes all inset parking areas in line with the footway where they may occur and full footway parking within marked bays in: **Cogan Avenue** (east side – between Billet Road and Gurney Close), **Cooper Avenue** (south-west side between Banbury Road and Lawrence Road and north-east side between Banbury Road and Valognes Avenue), **Valognes Avenue** (both sides), **Lawrence Avenue** (eastern and southern sides)

3. The general effect of the Orders referred to in paragraph 1(b) above will be, as an experiment, to:-

- (a) Extend the **HIGHAM HILL (HH) CPZ** (extension 2) to include the following roads: **Priors Croft, Rodney Place, Warwick Road** and **Windsor Avenue**;
- (b) introduce new permit holder parking places and waiting restrictions into the streets and parts of streets mentioned in paragraph 3(a) above in all locations surrounding designated parking places;
- (c) introduce formal disabled person's parking places (for disabled blue badge holders only) into: **Warwick Road (WW)** (north-east side (total of 2 bays) – outside Nos. 12/14 and 32/34 WW);

4. The general effect of the Orders referred to in paragraph 1(c) above will be, as an experiment, to:-

- (a) Extend the **WOOD STREET NORTH (WSN) CPZ** to include the following road: **Wigram square**
- (b) introduce Wigram Square as a permit holder parking place indicated by the sign "*Permit holders parking only past this point*" at its junction with Forest Road with no specific parking places marked on the carriageway. Waiting and loading restrictions will also be provided into that said street in specific locations;
- (c) introduce formal disabled person's parking places (for disabled blue badge holders only) into: **Wigram Square (WG)** (total of 2 bays) – outside Nos. 16 (x1) and 31 (x1) WG); and

all disabled person's parking places mentioned in this notice will operate "at any time" and will be at least 6.6 metres in length.

5. The Orders will provide that –

- (a) the operational hours for the permit parking places and / or “permit parking beyond this point” areas in:
- (i) **HHN** CPZ will be between **8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive**; and
 - (ii) **HH (extension 2)** CPZ will be between **8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive**;
 - (iii) **WSN (extension 1)** CPZ will be between **10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive**;
- (b) **residents'** permits, **business** permits, **charity** permits (*eligible for charities registered with the Charities Commission only*), **visitors'** permits, **school staff** term-time only permits, **residents' foreign** vehicle permits, **essential user** permits, **carers** permits and **tradespersons'** permits, may be granted, on payment of the appropriate charge as specified in item 7 following, to a person who is the keeper of a passenger vehicle (having 8 passenger seats or less) or a certain type of goods vehicle or a motor cycle, providing that in the case of -
- (i) a **residents'** permit, they are a resident of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and their vehicle is UK registered to that address;
 - (ii) a **foreign vehicles residents'** permit, they are a resident of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and their vehicle is registered outside of the UK;
 - (iii) a **business** permit or charity permit or business visitor's permit, they have a business or charitable organisation in a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in a Schedule to this Notice and that the permit is for a vehicle which is essential to the operation of that business or charity and is used in the purchase and sale of goods or services in connection with that business or charity;
 - (iv) an **essential users** permit or carers permit, they are either a doctor or carer who has a surgery in or works in the London Borough of Waltham Forest, or employed by or contracted to the Council, or employed by or contracted to a health authority, or employed by the Metropolitan Police (including Police officers), or employed by the London Fire and Civil Defence Authority, or a company that services fire-fighting appliances and for whom the use of a vehicle is essential to the carrying out of their public service duties, or to any carer registered with the Council who is in receipt of a DWP Carers Allowance and who is providing care to a resident living in a CPZ in the London Borough of Waltham Forest ('the borough'), regardless of whether or not that carer resides in the borough, in a street or part of a street specified in items 2, 3 or 4 preceding; *The Council will, in addition, consider applications for a carers permit on a case by case basis from carers who are not in receipt of a DWP Carers Allowance but who provide care to a resident living in a CPZ in the borough. Medical documents will need to be provided to the Council by the resident receiving care to support such an application. In such a case the carers permit will be charged at the current resident parking permit charge rates.*
 - (v) a **school staff** term-time only permit, they are a registered member of staff at a primary or secondary school situated in a street or part of a street specified in items 2(a), 3(a) or 4(a) preceding, who has a bona fide reason to drive to that school;
 - (vi) a **tradespersons** permit, which may be applied for by CPZ residents on the behalf of tradespersons engaged in work at their home address in or near a street or part of a street specified in items 2(a), 3(a) or 4(a) preceding; or
 - (vii) a **visitors'** permit, if they are a resident of a property on any **land situated between Nos. 64 and 66 Priors Croft** or part of a property eligible to purchase permits as listed in any Schedule to this Notice and that such visitors permit is to be used by a bona fide visitor to their home.
- (c) vehicles displaying any valid permit displaying the letters:
- (i) **HHN** may use any of the permit parking places provided in the streets and parts of streets specified in paragraph 2(a) above; or
 - (ii) **HH (extension 2)** may use any of the permit parking places provided in the streets and parts of streets specified in paragraph 3(a) above or in any street within the existing HH CPZ;
 - (iii) **WSN (extension 1)** may use any of the permit parking places provided in the streets and parts of streets specified in paragraph 4(a) above or in any street within the existing WSN CPZ
- (d) other than in the permit parking places, or as the case may be “permit parking beyond this point” areas and disabled persons parking places:
- (i) referred to in item 2 above, waiting and loading by vehicles will be restricted to prevent obstructive parking either (1) **'at any time'**, at road junctions, certain drop kerbs and certain other lengths to prevent obstructive parking at all times; or (2) **between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive** in all other parts of streets within the **HHN** CPZ.
 - (ii) referred to in item 3 above, waiting and loading by vehicles will be restricted to prevent obstructive parking either (1) **'at any time'**, at road junctions, certain drop kerbs and certain other lengths to prevent

obstructive parking at all times; (2) **between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive** in all other parts of streets within the **HH CPZ**;

(iii) referred to in item 4 above, waiting and loading by vehicles will be restricted to prevent obstructive parking either (1) **'at any time'**, at road junctions, certain drop kerbs and certain other lengths to prevent obstructive parking at all times; (2) **between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive** in all other parts of streets within Wigram Square (**WSN CPZ**);

6. The properties specified in:

- (a) **Schedule 1** to this Notice will be eligible in respect of permits to park in the **HHN CPZ**;
 - (b) **Schedule 2** to this Notice will be eligible in respect of permits to park in the **HH (extension 2) CPZ**;
 - (c) **Schedule 3** to this Notice will be eligible in respect of permits to park in the **WSN (extension 1) CPZ**;
- And

7. The charges for permits (per vehicle band, where applicable) for use in the permit holders' parking places referred to in items 2(a), 3(a) and 4(a) preceding are as follows:

Other permits (any vehicle band): Residents' visitor permits – 1 hour, £0.60p (60 permits per year free to over 60s); **Business** visitor permit – 1 hour, £1.35; All-Zone Business Visitor's Permit – 1 hour, £1.90; **Essential** User Permit – 1 month, £60; Essential users pool (multiple vehicles) permit - 12 months, £530; **Resident's pool** (multiple vehicles) permit – 12 months, 1st vehicle £150, 2nd vehicle £275, 3rd vehicle plus £360; **Business pool** (multiple vehicles) permit – 12 months, 1st vehicle £675, 2nd vehicle £995, 3rd vehicle

plus £1,320; **Charity pool** (multiple vehicles) permit – 12 months, 1st vehicle £110, 2nd vehicle £160, 3rd vehicle plus £220; **Tradesperson's** permit – single zone - 7 days, £35; Tradesperson's permit –single zone - 28 days, £110. Services charges for change of VRM or change of address £10, for refunds £15 (refunds under £1 not permitted) and lost or stolen permits, £10. *Note: All Residents' visitor Permits will be capped to a maximum of 10 hours on the number of 1 hour visitor permits required to permit all-day visitor parking in any CPZ where the permitted hours are more than 10 hours in duration.*

7. Where it appears necessary for certain purposes, an authorised officer of the Council may, in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, modify or suspend any provision of the experimental Traffic Orders while they are in force.

9. The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Traffic Orders should be continued in force indefinitely by means of permanent Traffic Orders made under sections 6, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Any person may object to the making of the permanent Orders for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of six months beginning with the day on which the experimental Orders come into force or, if the Orders are varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force. Any such objection must be made in writing and must state the grounds on which it is made and be sent to: Traffic Orders, Highways, Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS, or by emailing: **traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk**:
 - (a) in respect of an Order referred to in paragraph 1(a) above, reference **T37a(20) – HIGHAM HILL NORTH (HHN) CPZ**; or
 - (b) in respect of an Order referred to in paragraph 1(b) above, reference **T37b(20) – HIGHAM HILL (HH) – (extension 2) CPZ**;
 - (c) in respect of an Order referred to in paragraph 1(b) above, reference **T37c(20) – WOOD STREET NORTH –(extension 1) CPZ**Any objection may be communicated to, or be seen by, other persons who may be affected.
10. If any person wishes to question the validity of any the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
