The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Grove Green Road Region) (No. 1) Traffic Order
2020

Made 8th October 2020

Coming into Operation: see Article 1

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

1. **Citation, commencement and interpretation**

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation for the purposes of all provisions of this Order on 8th October 2020.
- 1.2 This Order may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Grove Green Road Region) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2020;
- 1.3 In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires “prescribed street” means any length of street in the London borough of Waltham Forest mentioned in Article 2 of this Order

2. **Prohibitions**

- 2.1 No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Grove Green Road E11 in the London Borough of Waltham Forest to turn left into:
 - (a) Scarborough Road E11; or
 - (b) Southwest Road E11;between 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. throughout the week.
- 2.2 No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Southwest Road E11 in the London Borough of Waltham Forest to turn left into Avebury Road E11 between 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. throughout the week.

3. **Exemptions**

(a) 1984 c.27

3.1 Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply in relation to:-

- (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
- (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden;
- (c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- (d) to a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority whilst undertaking a statutory power or duty in a prescribed street; and
- (e) pedal cycles

4. **Revocations**

4.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Grove Green Road region) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2019(a) and The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Grove Green Road region) (No. 1) (Modification No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2019(b) are hereby revoked in their entirety.

5. **Placing of Traffic Signs, etc**

The Council shall:

- 5.1 place and maintain adequate and appropriate traffic signs indicating the prescribed routes imposed by this Order; and
- 5.2 carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of such prescribed routes.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order prohibits vehicles turning left from Grove Green Road into either Scarborough Road or Southwest Road; and from Southwest Road into Avebury Road (all E11 streets) at specific times every day of the week, on a permanent basis, in the London Borough of Waltham Forest.

The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Canberra Path No. 1) Traffic Order 2020

Made 8th October 2020

Coming into operation – see Article 1

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

1. Citation and commencement

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation for the purposes of all provisions of this Order on 8th October 2020;
- 1.2 This Order may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Canberra Path No. 1) Traffic Order 2020.

2. Prohibitions

- 2.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order:
- (a) no person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Whitney Road E10 in the London Borough of Waltham Forest to enter Canberra Path E10 at any time; and
- (b) no person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in a southerly direction in Melbourne Road E10, in the London Borough of Waltham Forest, to turn right into Canberra Path E10 at any time;

3. Placing of Traffic Signs, etc

The Council shall:

- 3.1 place and maintain adequate and appropriate traffic signs indicating the prescribed routes imposed by this Order; and
- 3.2 carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of such prescribed routes.

4. **Exemptions**

4.1 Nothing in Article 2.1(a) or 2.1(b) of this Order shall apply in relation to:-

- (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
- (b) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or
- (c) a pedal cycle.

4.2 Nothing in Article 2.1(b) of this Order shall apply in relation to ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes.

5. **Revocation**

5.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Canberra Path No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2019(a) is hereby revoked in its entirety.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order provides a ban on entering Canberra Path from Whitney Road and a right turn ban into Canberra Path E10 from Melbourne Road E10 on a permanent basis, in the London Borough of Waltham Forest.
