**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The above Orders are considered necessary to provide adequate on-street parking facilities for either disabled persons, residents, business', essential users, visitors and vehicles that require adequate space for loading and unloading. To improve, the flow of traffic, sight lines for drivers at road junctions where new lengths of waiting restrictions are implemented so as to improve road safety and amenity, prevent obstruction (which in certain cases will be to maintain communal access such as dropped kerbs).

The Orders also seek to correct minor drafting discrepancies for previously made Orders namely in those sites mentioned and described in item 3 of the Notice of Proposal.

Following on from the success of the Bikehangar programme the council has been investigating ways to extend the scheme to reflect the diverse nature of the types of bikes being used by its residents. Following the request of a resident to identify and support a shift towards active travel in the area we have decided to implement a cargo bike parking solution on Belgrave Road E17 (removal of 5 metres of permit parking space). This has the support of the resident and the immediate neighbours.

The proposed Order for 20 m.p.h. speed limit is considered necessary to improve safety and reduce personal injury and road accidents in Argall Way and Argall Avenue industrial area in E10.
